Teen Dental Program - \$1000 Dental for kids

Children in your family are now entitled to up to \$1,000 in basic dental care, over two consecutive years.

Services include examinations, x-rays, cleaning, fillings, root canals and extractions.

The Child Dental Benefits Schedule is available to children who are aged between 2 and 17 years old for at least one day in the calendar year and are eligible for Medicare.

They also need to be part of a family that receives a relevant Australian government payment such as the Family Tax Benefit Part A. The scheme replaces the Medicare Teen Dental Plan.

Families can use the full benefit of \$1,000 for each child in the first year if needed. If the child does not use it all, they can use what is left in the second year if the child is still eligible.

Advise your families to let the dental clinic know they will be using the Child Dental Benefits Schedule. For information about their children's benefits, they can call 132 011 or use a myGov account at my.gov.au.

If eligible, your family would have received a letter about the new Child Dental Benefits Scheme, from the Department of
