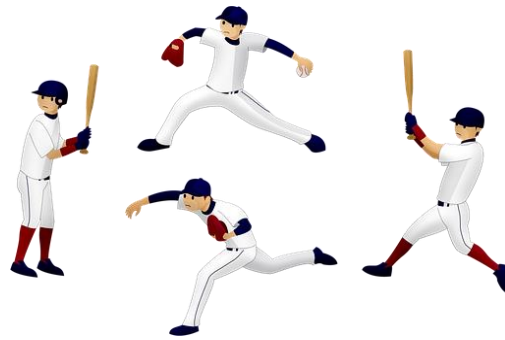

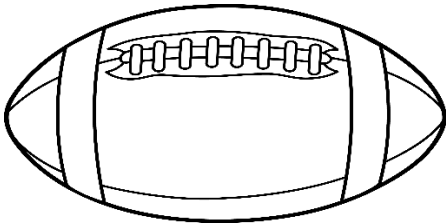

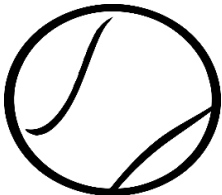

Rule	Examples
We say <i>to play</i> or <i>playing</i> when we talk about sports that use a ball.	I like to play tennis. My brother likes playing tennis.
We use <i>to go</i> with sports that end in an <i>-ing</i> word. We can also use these words by themselves after <i>like, love, hate/prefer</i> .	I like to go swimming. My sister hates swimming.
We use the verb <i>do</i> with the names of activities that you can do by yourself.	My mother does yoga. I do yoga on weekends.
